All Students are required to fill the Online reporting form for online reporting. Before filling the google form, you have to pay balance fee through online mode only using link given below. It is mandatory to fill this google form on or before **July 29 2022** and upload required document for registration for semester I, 2022-23. Please check your email regularly for further update. (By 1700 Hrs)

Online reporting Process for Semester-I, 2022-23 **(BDes Program)**

Candidates who are admitted to the Institute are required to upload the following documents at the time of online reporting in the institute on 29th July 2022

- The downloaded Document Verification-cum-Seat Acceptance letter issued by the VC in charge and Latest Provisional Seat allotment letter.
- Class X (High School) Board Certificate as proof of date of birth and name (in case of any mismatch an affidavit is to be uploaded along with the X certificate).
- Class XII Mark sheet and Certificate
- JEE Main/UCEED Score Card
- Transfer, Character & Migration certificate. You are required to submit original document at the time of Physical reporting.
- Certificate of category (OBC / SC / ST /EWS), if applicable, issued by the competent authority. (OBC/EWS certificate must be issued on or after May 1, 2022 in central Govt. format) as per JOSAA/CSAB/UCEED). Candidates of Maharashtra State need to submit the caste validity certificate issued by the competent authority or the declaration as on JoSAA/UCEED website.
- Certificate for Persons with Disabilities (PWD), if applicable. It must be issued by a medical board as per the Government rules.
- Receipt for balance fees payment

Additionally, at the time of Physical reporting you should bring the following duly filled-in forms, downloadable from the Institute website (at the time of Physical reporting).

- Medical Certificate of fitness from the doctor, not below the rank of Senior Medical Officer in prescribed format.
- Anti-Ragging Affidavit on Stamp Paper of Rs. 50/- by the student & Anti-Ragging Affidavit on Stamp Paper of Rs. 50/- by the Parents/Guardians. prescribed format (at the time of Physical reporting)
- Online fee Receipt (Balance Institute Fees)
- Good quality passport photograph (front facing)
